## Maths

In maths we will focus on place value, addition and subtraction and time and shape. We use lots of games to support our learning and use a more practical approach to problem solving in the classroom.

We will be developing our confidence in numbers during the first half term.



## Reading

### Our reading curriculum

In our class we hear the children read 1:1 every day. We encourage lots of independent reading during lessons to help create more fluent, confident readers! It is important that children read at home at least three times a week to support this.

### Love of reading

We love to listen to stories and just before lunch we either enjoy listening to a story from our class library read by Miss West or watching Newsround to find out what is going on in the world around us.

## Religious Education

In the Autumn Term, we revisit the parable of the mustard seed.



We also learn about what makes our world a wonderful place and focusing on places that are special to us.

## Life skills

In Blossom our Curriculum is planned with a structure that enables personalised learning depending on individual needs. We recognise that some important life skills will help the children as they move through school and into their adult lives.
