What are we learning this week in Year 4?

English

We will be planning and writing our own versions of The Lost Thing using agreed success criteria from our sentence stacking lessons. We will be editing and improving our work before sharing with other children in Year 4.

Spelling

Our focus this week, will be words with prefixes to give an opposite meaning.

Reading

Our teaching text this week using Cracking Comprehension is an extract from Gangster Granny by David Walliams focusing on different skills in order to answer specific questions within a text. We will complete this from last week before our independent task to assess the skills taught. In History we will be reading a text about Howard Carter. Please encourage your child to read each night and use Reading Plus.

Maths

We will be practising times table daily and completing a morning task based on prior learning including calculations in order to increase fluency. Our Maths objectives will focus on rounding numbers. Each day the children will be exposed to Reasoning and Problem-Solving questions as well as Fluency.

Please ensure your child is using Times Table Rock Stars at home.

Science

In Science we will be focusing on the role of evaporation and condensation in the water cycle linking to our learning about states of matter in particular water and how it can change state, why and what happens to the particles.

History

We will continue to look at sources of evidence relating to the Discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb in 1922. After that, we will be focusing on the Rover Nile and its importance in Ancient Egypt.
